There will be no vote taken at this meeting and there will be no vote taken at the Community Board 8 Board Meeting being held on April 18, 2018 at the Hillcrest Jewish Center, located at 183-02 Union Turnpike. The Board has taken the stand that it will not vote on any type of health facility serving the developmentally disabled that wants to move into our community for the following reasons:

- 1. Saturation/Concentration has never been defined under the New York's Site Selection Law.
- 2. Finding the applicant an alternate site is almost impossible.
- 3. The New York State law is in conflict with the Federal ADA guidelines.
