1 2 CHAIR DO: Good morning. I am 3 calling this meeting to order at 10:06 a.m. I am David Do, 4 Commissioner and Chair of the Taxi and 5 Limousine Commission. It's great to 6 7 see everyone in person this morning. And I'm joined today by the board of 8 9 commissioners, Commissioner Kaufman, Commissioner Sorrentino, Commissioner 10 Mitchell and Commissioner Bader. 11 12 A few words before we get onto 13 our votes. We have a rule proposal up 14 for a vote today that can improve the life of our city. Our Green Rides 15 16 Initiative. If passed, New York will 17 become the first large city in America to require its rideshare fleet to be 18 either wheelchair accessible or zero 19 20 emissions by 2030. 21 "Being the first" is a phrase we 22 use a lot in New York City. But we 23 are not proposing this to be the 24 first. We are proposing this because 25 our world is slipping deeper into a

2	climate crisis. According to the
3	National Oceanic Atmospheric
4	Administration, 2023 is about to
5	surpass 2016 as the hottest year on
б	record. We are breaking records like
7	this regularly. We have a chance to
8	do something about it.
9	We are at a crossroads at which
10	with the widespread adoption of new
11	technology allows us to embark on a
12	more responsible path towards cleaner
13	air, a safer and more accessible city.
14	And a more hopeful future. This rule
15	will not be fully implemented
16	overnight. No one will be forced to
17	buy a zero-emissions vehicle or a
18	wheelchair-accessible vehicle
19	tomorrow, next week or even next
20	month.
21	Drivers will transition when the
22	time is right for them. In tandem
23	with developing charging
24	infrastructure and price parity with
25	ICE vehicles. We may be the first,

but I'm fully confident that as we begin to reap the rewards of this transition, it will become abundantly clear that we will not be the last. On that note, let's get onto our votes.

Today we are voting on two rule proposals. The first rule will change the payment structure for the Verrazano-Narrows Bridge tolls. Our original rule proposal required that the passenger would pay double the toll going into Staten Island, and a new passenger would pay the toll to leave Staten Island. After reviewing public comment, the final rule proposal would ask the passenger to pay double toll to enter Staten Island and no toll to leave, reverting to the toll system that used to be in place. In addition, this payment scheme would also apply to passengers using the Cross Bay Veterans Bridge and the

1 2 Bridge to enter Rockaway Peninsula, as 3 there is no way to exit the Rockaways without using the bridge. 4 5 The second rule proposal establishes our Green Rides 6 7 Initiative, which would require high 8 volume for-hire vehicles services, 9 such as Uber and Lyft, to dispatch vehicles that are 100 percent either 10 zero-emission or wheelchair-accessible 11 12 by 2030. The rules establish a ramp 13 schedule at five percent to dispatch 14 to such vehicles in 2024, and slowly 15 ramps up to 100 percent in 2030. 16 After reviewing public comment, 17 the final version of the rule is the 18 same as proposed except for one change: Data collection will not 19 include the VIN of the vehicle's 20 21 dispatch. 22 Before I go onto the votes, I 23 would like to recognize Commissioner 24 Kaufman for some comments. 25 MS. KAUFMAN: Thank you,

1 Commissioner Do. 2 3 Before we vote, I would like to say I'm so glad that New York is 4 working to be first in this initiative 5 to develop a solution for both 6 7 sustainable and accessible 8 transportation. And I look forward to 9 collaborating on this effort with you. I would also like to acknowledge 10 that much of the widespread adoption 11 12 of electric vehicles to Taxi and Limousine Commission drivers is 13 14 contingent on factors outside of this 15 organization. 16 So while I vote yes today, Ι 17 hope that a number -- the number of 18 chargers that are publicly accessible 19 and widely distributed and with 20 sufficient uptime will be made available to keep pace with the 21 22 adoption of these vehicles. And if 23 they're not, within a couple of years 24 I hope to move for a vote to amend the 25 policy according to the pace of

ELUTO: And thank you. The 13 motion is adopted unanimously. 14 MR. CANCEL: Thank you. 15 MS. ELUTO: Commissioners, we 16 now turn to item five on the agenda, 17 the Verrazzano-Narrows Bridge toll 18 rule proposal package. 19 The proposed rules were 20 published in the city record on 21 July 10, 2023 for public comment. Α 22 public hearing was held by the TLC on 23 August 9th. And on October 13th, the 24 final version of the proposed rule was posted on our website and circulated 25

All those in favor of adopting 6 the rules amended, please raise your 7 hand. 8 (Raised hands from Commissioners.) 9 MS. ELUTO: Great. The rule is 10 11 adopted unanimously. 12 And, Commissioners, we now turn to item six on the agenda. Which will 13 be the Green Rides Initiative. Give 14 me one second -- I can tell you what 15 16 day they were published in the city record --17 Green Rides Initiative, they 18 19 were published in the city record on 20 August 16th for public comment, and on 21 September 20, 2023, we held a public hearing. The final version was sent 22 23 to the Commissioners and published on 24 our website on October 13th. Can we 25 now call for a vote?

1 2 Commissioners, how do we vote? In favor? 3 CHAIR DO: Yes. 4 5 (Raised hands by Commissioners.) MS. ELUTO: Yes. So the vote is 6 7 unanimous. Thank you very much. 8 David, Commissioner, any additional business? 9 CHAIR DO: Well, this has been 10 11 an incredible day to see a unanimous 12 vote on such an important path towards a more sustainable, accessible city. 13 14 I'm excited for the path forward, I'm 15 excited for the implementation and I'm 16 excited to work with all our 17 Commissioners to get to a greener 18 city. 19 And so thank you so much today 20 for your vote and commitment to our city's future.
